These will be placed at our designated station and will be used as spare units in case needed and will only be pulled out upon return/delivery of the same. Where the spare units within the contract agreed quantity are consumed, no additional charge shall be bill to PEATC.		
3. The Service Provider shall warrant that the services to be rendered will be as per plan and specifications requested by PEATC. Should PEATC find the services to be ineffective as evidenced by the unsealed gaps PEATC reserves the right to terminate the contract. In such case, PEATC shall not be obliged to pay the contractor for services rendered.		
4. The Service Provider shall provide parts for replacement, service warranty at a level to be agreed with PEATC.
