

**PHILIPPINE RECLAMATION AUTHORITY  
CY 2023 SUMMARY OF  
SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM ACTIVITIES**

To enhance the economic and social well-being of its host communities and uplift their quality of life, the Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA) executed a series of initiatives in 2023, under the direction of its Environmental Management Department (ENV), in Tanza, Naic, Ternate, and Maragondon, Cavite. The programs, projects, and activities are results of the close consultation with our targeted stakeholders. These actions were part of a concerted effort to ensure the Agency's operations delivered lasting and sustainable benefits.

As part of PRA's commitments in its Social Development and Management Program (SDMP), the Agency launched enterprise development and networking programs. These initiatives emphasized fostering an entrepreneurial mindset among fisherfolk leaders and communities and provided support for livelihood and community engagement activities. This encompassed organizing livelihood and leadership skills training, as well as financial management workshops. The impact of these programs was profound, benefiting fourteen fisherfolk communities across thirteen barangays.

The PRA's commitment extended to healthcare access and services, with the introduction of health programs, medical and dental missions, medicine distributions, and efforts to combat health threats like dengue through the provision of misting machines and solutions. These health initiatives positively affected approximately thirty-five thousand residents.

Education support was another critical area of focus for the PRA. The Agency assisted the youth by improving school infrastructures, including the construction of literacy and numeracy gardens including improvement of comfort rooms and handwashing facilities, supporting hydroponics and greenhouse projects, and supplying educational materials. These educational support efforts reached around seventeen thousand students in the host municipalities.

Moreover, the PRA invested in Institutional Capacity Building and support for local law enforcement in coastal communities. This included training for "Bantay Bayan Officers" and "Bantay Dagat" volunteers on environmental laws and providing them with necessary equipment such as heavy-duty flashlights, speakers, megaphones, safety and rescue gear, and GPS devices.

Here is a condensed overview of the PRA's Social Development and Management Program (SDMP) activities across its host communities and the beneficiaries of these initiatives:
